Project Summary

This project focused on raising awareness among high school students about digital citizenship, e-safety, and environmental sustainability. Through international collaboration, students engaged in individual and group activities, produced digital content, and improved key 21st-century skills.

In the 2024-2025 Academic Year, we participated in the eTwinning project called "CITIZENSHIP AND ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS IN THE DIGITAL AGE" created on the ESEP portal by our Biology teacher Ayla GÜNDÜZ KURT and our Biology teacher Ardiana Marku from Shkodra / Albania "Pashko Vasa" Secondary School. The project is carried out with the participation of 16 teachers and 83 students (13-18 years old) from 5 different countries (Turkey, Romania, Albania, Azerbaijan, Greece). Our project is a 4-month eTwining project that will take place between January 2025 and April 2025.

Objectives Achieved

- Promoting digital citizenship and safe online behavior
- Increasing environmental awareness and responsibility
- Enhancing student collaboration and digital skills
- Creating original, curriculum-integrated products
- Supporting democratic participation and active learning

- E-safety quiz and "Safer Internet Day" activities
- Collaborative SDG videos
- "Green Future Map" and "From Waste to Art" projects
- Infographics, e-books, e-magazine, virtual exhibition
- Student & teacher online meetings and evaluations

Assessment and Evaluation

Pre- and post-surveys were applied to measure impact. Feedback was collected via Padlet and TwinSpace forums. All activities were evaluated monthly, and results showed strong engagement and learning outcomes.

Dissemination: Project activities were shared via the school's website, social media platforms, and bulletin boards. Final outputs were presented through QR codes, a virtual exhibition, and an e-magazine.
